- Austin from Great West Engineering presented the Water Supply Project Update for May 2025 which included the hydrologic study and analysis of Hawkins Park. He also restated possible issues with proceeding in Hawkins Park due to current flood plain and floodway regulations and zoning. Other possible sites for test wells were discussed.
- Mike would like to get an appraisal of Hawkins Park property and would it be possible to use ARPA funds to buy the property. Kasia from Great West Engineering joined briefly to inform us that ARPA funds CAN be used to buy any property to put wells on.
- The Board decided to table an appraisal of Hawkins Park for now.
- Mike brought up the idea of possibly studying and refurbishing the old Firehall Well (which is right next to the Absarokee Water Office). That well produced 100gpm in the past and Jason mentioned that with new well drilling techniques it could possibly produce more. Austin agreed and informed us he could have one of their experts come out and inspect the well sometime in the beginning of June.

# <u>Motion:</u> Alan moved to get the Firehall Well ready for inspection and Roger seconded.
